

Portal Capes Term of Use

Authorized Users

2.1 - are allowed to access the Portal users at participating institutions of this program:

- * Permanent Faculty, temporary and visiting professors;
- * Undergraduate and graduate students;
- * Permanent and Temporary Staff

2.2 - Access to the Portal is free, restricted to authorized users and allowed exclusively through the stations installed on the Universities and Institutions or places associated with them.

Portal Capes Term of Use

3.3 - Authorized users have the right to view, without any restrictions, the digital storage (download), printing and copying **items of publications** available on the Portal for individual use and in its teaching and research and other academic programs.

3.5 - A **publication item** is defined here as an individual article, a chapter or any other part of a document, not being permitted copying, printing or digital storage (download) the **full text** of any publication or full of periodicals.

3.6 - It is not allowed, under any circumstances, use of the publications available on Portal for commercial purposes, directly or indirectly, or even for **any purposes** that may violate **applicable copyright**.

3.7 - no warning on the copyright warning disclaimer of responsibility and any screens including suppliers by publications in documents available on the Portal may be withdrawn, modified or obstructed.

3.8 - The institutions and their authorized users can not perform reverse engineering on the service provided by the Portal or install robots or intelligent agents to access, browse and / or systematically making digital storage (download) any part licensed products.

4 - SERVICE EXCHANGE BETWEEN LIBRARIES

4.1 - In addition to the conditions set out in paragraphs 3.5, 3.6 and 3.7 above shall apply

The following in exchange between libraries offered by institutions norms related.

4.2 - Institutions may copy items to fulfill requests for exchanges between libraries **provided such service is expressly permitted by the copyright laws copyright applicable.**

4.3 - Documents may only be provided in printed form, as photocopying or sent by fax or Ariel.

4.4 - Institutions may charge only the costs related to playing item and shipping by mail or facsimile transmission.

4.5 - Only requests from educational institutions can be met and research and non-profit institutions **located in the country**

3. USE RESTRICTIONS

- (a) sell, distribute, license, rent, or otherwise exploit the Licensed Materials, or any element thereof, for any commercial use;
- (b) make the Licensed Material or any part of it, by any means available to a person who is not an Authorized User;
- (c) make the Licensed Material or any element of it, available on or by means, electronic, online newsletters, newsgroups, websites, FTP or other means to publish or download material from the Internet, online services or network Local area;
- (d) remove or obliterate the claims of copyright Licensor of the Licensed Material, including physical copies printed;
- (e) Use the Licensed Material to create any work, derivative product or service, or merge the Licensed Material with any other product, database or service;

1. Rights and restrictions governing access to Wiley Online Library
 - a. Authorised users can download, search, retrieve, display and view, copy and save to hard disk or diskette and store or print copies unique individual articles, chapters or entries in Electronic Products licensed for personal, academic, educational, or scientific research use Authorized User, or for internal company use. Authorized Users can also convey these materials to third parties or printed copies electronic, for personal or academic, educational, scientific or research use or professional use but in no case for resale, redistribution systematic, or any other use. In addition, authorized users have right to use, with appropriate credit, figures, tables and summarized extracts several articles, chapters or other inputs of Electronic Products licensed in own scientific, scholarly and educational work of the User authorized, such as books and articles

b. All authorized users have the option of creating a profile page (My Profile), which allow them to create data files and links to articles, chapters and entries of interest in the authorized electronic products and criteria research that can be reused by them

c. Licensee and its Authorized Users **can create links** to the Library Wiley Online records of their catalog online public access (OPAC, Online Public Access Catalog), library catalogs, link resolvers, databases hosted locally or internet pages of libraries, provided that such links are operated by the licensee in a secure network, not result in material licensed to anyone besides the user accesses authorized and shall not be used in connection with any paid service or Commercial or for any commercial use whatsoever

d. Authorized Users that are members of the faculty or staff
Licensee may download and print multiple copies of the materials of
